

Glass Park RV Campground is closed.

U.S. Army Alaska has decided to construct Family Housing in Glass Park.

The three pavilions with playgrounds in Glass Park are not part of the family housing project. However much of Glass Park will be a construction site in the summer of 2007 and beyond until the Housing Project is completed. Once construction begins, the park is likely to be noisy and congested with construction traffic.

The Outdoor Recreation Director is in contact with the Corps of Engineers Project Manager. As of 16 April 2007, the Corps has received bids on this design build project. A contractor has not yet been selected.

The start dates of actual construction are unknown at this point. All we know is that construction will begin sometime this summer. We have been told there will be no camping in any part of Glass Park this year.

Outdoor Recreation, Bldg 4050 and the Boat Launch will remain open this summer. There is no plan to move Outdoor Recreation in the future.

We are sorry for this inconvenience. There are many campgrounds in the Fairbanks area as well as a Family Camp at Eielson Air Force Base.
